Authorised aids for exams for the Bachelor's and Master's programs in Health Sciences at the Faculty of Health Sciences and Medicine at the University of Lucerne

Basic principles

Examination modalities are regulated in §§ 27 - 33 of the Study and Examination Regulations for the Bachelor's and Master's programs in Health Sciences at the Faculty of Health Sciences and Medicine at the University and the guidelines for the individual degree programs.

This information sheet also regulates the use of aids during examinations and applies to all examinations in the Health Sciences degree programs, unless other regulations have been communicated in the individual courses. If other regulations have been communicated in the individual courses, then these other regulations have the priority.

Permitted aids

1. All documents required for the examination will be handed out to you on site. Only the following are permitted on site
 - a. Drinking bottle
 - b. Writing utensils
 - c. Campus-Card
 - d. Exceptions: approved aids

Bags, jackets, cases and cell phones may not be taken directly to the workplace. Cell phones must be switched off during the examination.

2. Writing utensils: Students may use writing utensils, pens (no pencils!), rulers and similar during examinations.
3. Specific aids: In some cases, specific aids such as calculators or formulae sheets may be permitted. The admission of such aids will be announced in advance by the respective lecturer or examination coordinator.

For examinations for which the responsible lecturer explicitly permits the use of a "simple pocket calculator", only the following TI-30 models may be used:

Models with the suffix "Pro" are not permitted! This also applies to all other pocket calculators, regardless of their range of functions.

Calculators may only be taken into the examination without a cover.

If there is a suspicion that an unauthorized calculator is present in a specific case, the name of the student(s) and the manufacturer and model of the calculator will be noted. If the subsequent clarification by the Office of the Dean of Studies reveals that the calculator does not fall under the category of "simple calculators", the use of the calculator constitutes unfair examination conduct. In this case, the performance will be assessed with a grade of 1.0.

4. Approved aids according to the individually granted compensation for disadvantages.

Aids not permitted

1. Own writing paper: note paper will be provided. Additional paper can be requested from the exam invigilators at any time.
2. Textbooks: Unless otherwise stated, textbooks and other written materials are not permitted during examinations.
3. Notes: Unless otherwise stated, students may not use their own notes and summaries.
4. Any other electronic communication devices: The use of cell phones, smartwatches or other communication devices during examinations is strictly prohibited, unless expressly permitted by the examination supervisors.
5. Unauthorized materials: Students may not use unauthorized materials such as cheat sheets, other people's notes or unauthorized electronic devices.

Consequences of violations

The supervisors will carry out appropriate checks. In the event of irregularities during examinations, Section 31 of the Study and Examination Regulations for the Bachelor's and Master's degree programs in Health Sciences at the Faculty of Health Sciences and Medicine of the University shall come into force.
