

## Notes on the examination review for fall semester 2020

From the date of publication of the respective grades, students with unsatisfactory grades in particular usually have the opportunity to view their examinations taken. A possible administrative appeal must be made within the required period of 30 days after delivery of the examination decision.

Unfortunately, due to the currently valid protection concept of the University of Lucerne (see [www.unilu.ch/safecorona](http://www.unilu.ch/safecorona)), an on-site inspection is not possible.

Therefore, the following applies to the inspection of examinations for the fall semester 2020:

1. Inspection of exams is currently only possible for cases of hardship. A case of hardship is considered to be one in which an unsatisfactory grade prevents the student from graduating by the end of fall term 2020 or one in which an unsatisfactory grade leads to an exclusion from the study program. Affected students should contact the Study Center directly by email ([Masterhealth@unilu.ch](mailto:Masterhealth@unilu.ch)). The exact implementation options (e.g. via ZOOM) are defined by the Study Center and communicated to the students.
2. For students with unsatisfactory grades, a physical examination inspection is planned as soon as the epidemiological situation and the university protection concept allow it again. The deadline for an administrative appeal will be extended accordingly.
