

Research Funding – Health Sciences and Medicine

Since January 1, 2021, the Department of Health Sciences and Medicine has received CHF 20,000 annually from the Research Commission budget for direct support of research projects or publications by the Department.

The following applications are supported:

Publications

The publication must be accepted by an academic journal or publisher and published in an open access journal listed in the Directory of Open Access Journals (<https://doaj.org/>) or a recognized hybrid journal. For book publications we recommend the UniLU Research Commission.

To be submitted are:

- Notification of Acceptance
- PDF of the publication
- Invoice, or amount of Open Access costs

Open Access costs can only be covered if the costs are not covered by the SNSF or another funding organization.

Projects

Smaller projects up to CHF 1'500 can be supported by the GWM Research Commission.

To be submitted are:

- Project Summary
- Exact description of what the funding is needed for
- Detailed budget
- As attachment, if it is a subproject of a larger project: detailed project proposal which has been submitted e.g. to the SNF.

Larger projects can be submitted to the UniLU Research Commission (min. CHF 1,000 to max. CHF 30,000).

Decision on funding

The members of the UniLU Research Commission (currently Sara Rubinelli and Gisela Michel) decide on the acceptance or rejection of the applications. In case of rejection, the application can be submitted again after a revision.

Dates

The applications can be submitted at any time.

Research Commission Budget – Health Sciences and Medicine

The applications are funded as long as the budget is sufficient.
