
SNF Sinergia Research Group Workshop September 12-13, 2022 Department of History and Philosophy of Science, University of Cambridge



Charles Darwin, On the Origin of Species (1859)

Format: Everyone reads and discusses every paper in plenum. One paper per session (1 hour), arranged chronologically according to topic. Each session begins with a *very* short statement by the author and ca. 10-minute comment by a fellow Sinergia member, followed by an open discussion. The comment should engage with the paper constructively and set the tone for a productive discussion to follow. Papers should be new work not yet circulated to the Sinergia group. If they are longer than ca. 15pp. (1.5 spaced, 12pt font), then please indicate a reduced page range to be read more carefully by the group.

On Tuesday afternoon, <u>Sachiko Kusokawa</u> (Cambridge) will join to discuss two projects relevant to our research group: *Transmitting Knowledge: Words, Images, and Instruments in Early Modern Europe* (2006) and the AHRC project "Diagrams, figures and the transformation of astronomy 1450-1650."

The workshop will begin with a reading of the *History of the Human Sciences* special issue and end with a general discussion.
