2. Accepted Language Certificates

The partner institutions accept the following language certificates and scores for admission to the dual master's degree program:¹

TOEFL (Internet-based): 86 (20 in reading and listening; 22 in speaking and writing) or higher

IELTS (Academic): 6.5 IELTS (min. 6 in each band)

Cambridge: 176 or higher

In order to be accepted, language certificates need to have been obtained within two years before the date of application to the program.

3. Conversion of Grades





The partner institutions convert grades according to the following table:

Grades below C+ (Carleton University) and/or lower than 4 (University of Lucerne) indicate that a course cannot be counted towards the dual MA degree. In such cases, no credits/ECTS are assigned.

If conversions of grades are not covered by this table, the partner institutions will decide jointly on these specific cases.
