The successful candidate is expected to represent the full range of the field of sociological theory in research and teaching. He/she should exhibit a well-established theoretical expertise, international visibility, and a record of substantial publications including contributions relating to empirical matters and to the central interests represented at the department (i.e. world society, organizations, media or networks). Teaching responsibilities include theory courses at the BA- and MA-level in "Social and Communication Sciences" and "Sociology" and also, if applicable, at the MA-level in "World Society and Global Governance".

The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences considers itself an interdisciplinary association of disciplines from the social sciences and the humanities. Aside from the general disciplinary requirements, the successful candidate should therefore also be versed in interdisciplinary research and teaching. All candidates are furthermore expected to have strong abilities to work in a team and should be willing to contribute to the further development of the Faculty.

Conditions of employment are governed by the terms of Article 2 of the appointment regulations of the University of Lucerne. In the interest of gender diversity in research and teaching, the University strongly encourages applications from women.
