The UNILU Center for Comparative Constitutional Law and Religion (CCCLR) Student Research Fellows Program invites post-graduate students and young scholars to participate in an international short fellowship.

The aim of the program is to allow fellows to gain research and writing experience in the international environment of an interdisciplinary center. The Fellows will also contribute to the work of the Center and be involved in its teaching and research activities to the extent possible.

Program Structure

The main part of the fellowship is devoted to research projects related to successful candidates' applications in collaboration with the CCCLR. It also aims to include the Fellow in other work conducted under the auspices of the Center. The Fellowship is awarded a stipend of 5,000 CHF and the approximate duration of the fellowship is between 6-8 weeks.

Eligibility Requirements

Post-graduate scholars as well as individuals with professional degrees, are welcome to apply. Applications (in English) from any country are welcome. The program is open to applicants regardless of gender or religion. A background in social sciences, in particular law and/or theology would be preferred.

Application Requirements

Please submit each of the following items:

- a) Letter of introduction
- b) Project abstract (250 words maximum)
- c) Project proposal (750 -1000 words)
- d) Curriculum Vitae
- e) Two professional letters of reference
