# Pietro Longo

Pietro Longo is Ph.D. Candidate in Middle-Eastern Studies at University of Naples l'Orientale. Graduated in International Relations and Area Studies (MA), he focuses his doctoral degree on the Islamic Law and its applicability in the today's Muslim world. He is developing a comprehensive research on the Islamic Constitutional theories and the nature of the Islamic State, according to the Sunni and Shiite contemporary doctrines, also analyzing the Constitutions adopted in some Muslim countries.

After the so-called "Arab Springs", Pietro started to study the processes of Constitution-making and the Constitutional politics adopted by the islamic parties, with main regards to the Tunisian scenario. His aim is to describe how Islamic Constitutional theories are to be applied in post-revolutionary countries. He is co-chair at the Italian Center for the Study of Political Islam (CISIP) and member of the editorial board of the CISIP official Journal - Rivista Italiana di Studi sull'Islam Politico.
