

Instructions for requesting and downloading Swiss HR-Barometer datasets on SWISSUBASE

1. Go to the website <https://www.swissubase.ch/>.
2. Enter the search terms «Swiss Human Relations Barometer» in the search box.
3. Choose the desired edition (year).

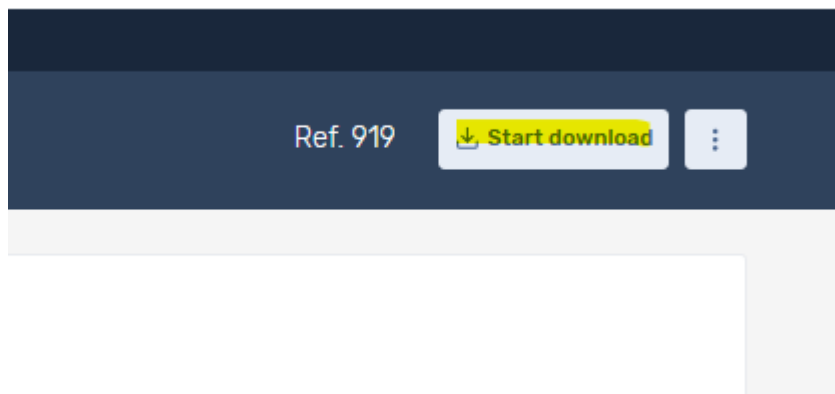
5. Klick on the title of the displayed dataset title.
