

## **Dual Degree in Political Science**

RESEARCH ORIENTATED - INTERNATIONAL - FOCUSED ON POLITICAL SCIENCE

The University of Lucerne together with Carleton University in Ottawa (Canada) are offering a Dual Master's Degree programme in Political Science. The study programme provides students with different accounts and experiences of this discipline. Its disciplinary focus on Political Science – without minor subjects – makes it possible to get a solid foundation in respect to theories and methods and it allows students to dig deeper into Political Science than it would be the case in multi-disciplinary study programmes.

## WHAT MAKES THE DUAL DEGREE IN POLITICAL SCIENCE SPECIAL:

- Despite being different in size, Switzerland and Canada share many characteristics, such as federalism and multi-lingualism. This generates many opportunities for mutual learning. While studying overseas, students from Lucerne find themselves in the centre of Canadian politics
   – in Ottawa, the capital city of Canada.
- In Lucerne and in Ottawa, all required courses are taught in English and students benefit from all courses offered by two political science departments.
- Students get to know two distinct academic cultures.
- Upon completion of their studies, students receive both a Swiss AND a Canadian Master's degree.
- Students registered at the University of Lucerne only pay tuition fees in Switzerland, even during the time they're studying in Ottawa.
