### *Introduction in Teaching and Learning*

**Content** This course is an introductory class in the basics of didactics and it is aimed at (post)doctoral students who are teaching lectures or seminars at the University of Lucerne. During the two-day workshop, the following elements will be discussed and trained:

- Key characteristics on successful teaching from a teaching research perspective
- Basic knowledge of general didactics, university teaching and teaching methods
- Good approaches for an effective course design
- Pathways to a personal theory-based planning scheme for organizing and preparing block courses
- Best practice for online teaching and blended learning sessions
- One-to-one training sessions

Further topics will be tailored accordingly to the participants' needs.

**Prerequisites/  
Materials** Participants will have to prepare a 15 minute teaching session in advance in order to be evaluated by the tutor and receive consultation and guidelines for their future teaching activity
