
UNIVERSITY OF LUCERNE

English-taught Summer School focusing on the theoretical and trial skills necessary to prepare for a career in defending human rights.



Exchange students live at the 'Student Mentor Foundation Lucerne' residence, 6 minutes by bus from the university campus.






TOP REASONS FOR AN EXCHANGE SEMESTER IN LUCERNE:






