Post-doctoral researcher (100%)

We offer a full-time position starting from the 1st of November 2017 (or by mutual agreement) within the Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF) project “Beyond Policy Adoption: Implications of Energy Policy on Parties, Publics, and Individuals“ (PYAPP1_173642: 2017-2021) lead by Prof. Dr. Lena Schaffer.

The PostDoc will conduct research independently as well as within the project on the distributional implications of energy transitions for individuals, civil society and parties. A minimum of a two-year commitment is requested, with a renewal of up to the total of four years. The gross salary is around 85.000 CHF/year (according to SNF guidelines: http://www.snf.ch/SiteCollectionDocuments/allg_doktorierende_d.pdf). Some funding for conference travel is available within the project. There is no teaching obligation. Besides the scientific work on the project, the postdoc should be prepared to help with advising students and doctoral candidates.

The ideal candidate should hold or be close to finishing a doctoral degree (PhD) in political science, or political economy/ economics. Applicants are expected to have strong methodological skills, ideally experience with conducting surveys (experiments), a strong interest in theoretical, as well as empirical issues within the field of comparative political economy / comparative environmental politics, and a strong command of English.

We look forward to receiving your application including a letter outlining your motivation and skills, as well as a CV, two writing samples (e.g., published articles or chapters from your dissertation), and your Bachelor and Master level study transcripts – all in one single pdf-file.
