## Talent Management: Conceptualisations, Tensions, and the Future of Work

Stefan Jooss is a Lecturer in Management and Programme Director for the Higher Diploma in Human Resource Management at Cork University Business School, University College Cork, Ireland. His main research interest and focus is in the areas of talent management, global mobility, and future of work.
