#### SUMMARY DISSERTATION

Health literacy (HL) is an important predictor for a number of health outcomes. The objective of my dissertation was to empirically and conceptually explore the concept of HL across different cultural contexts and to identify in how far patterns found concur with those found in other countries, mainly the US. Further, I aimed at contributing to the still ongoing debate on the conceptualization and operationalization of HL and, more importantly, the conceptual pathways that link HL to health disparities.
