#### I. ORGANIZATION

#### Schedule of classes

#### **Assignments**

- 1. Preparation: Each PhD candidate will have the opportunity to submit one of the following:
  - a. a draft paper for the selected conference or the selected journal. PhD candidates need to investigate potential target conferences and journals beforehand.
  - b. a draft paper for the dissertation
  - c. a PowerPoint presentation or a draft paper with idea(s) for a dissertation paper

All participants will submit their draft paper by a deadline date of **March 13** to Anja Feierabend (<u>anja.feierabend@unilu.ch</u>), who will forward them to all participants. The submitted draft should indicate the conference or journal selected as a target for the paper.

- 2. Presentation and discussion: PhD candidates will present their submitted papers in the plenary meeting on March 24. Additionally, some participants will play the role of the discussants. The discussants' presentations should be structured approximately as follows: Begin with a summary to acknowledge the major contributions of the work and then identify areas of weakness and suggestions for how to improve the paper (e.g., ideas for reorganizing the main ideas, suggestions about needs to be explained more fully or developed further, and identify potential practical implications). Each discussant will give the presenter a brief written document that summarizes these feedback comments, for use during the revision process. For each paper, 20 minutes will be available for the speaker, 10 minutes will be available for the discussant, and 30 minutes will be reserved for questions from the audience.
- 3. **Review**: PhD candidates, who would like to have ETCS points for the seminar, will submit a journal analysis for their paper to Anja Feierabend (anja.feierabend@unilu.ch) till 7th of April.
