CONTENT

Among the challenges that organizations face are questions related to their human resources. In the seminar HR Lab 2023, one organization provides a **current HR related question** as a topic to investigate. Students work in groups to find an **evidence-based solution** to this real-life HR case and present their findings in a **written project thesis** and in a **final presentation** in front of their peers and the project sponsor.

In this seminar, you interact with the organization to develop a scientific, evidence-based solution. To solve the organization's current HR challenge, you learn the basics of **project management**, you draw on **scientific literature** to approach the research question and you apply **empirical methods** to investigate it in order to develop an evidence-based solution. During the semester, you present and discuss your progress in the seminar.

Challenge 2023:

The demographic development in Switzerland leads to a skilled labour shortage. One option to mitigate the effects of a skilled labour shortage is to attract elderly people to the labour market. Therefore, we want to investigate what elements are important for elderly people to consider working beyond retirement age. (Company: HR ConScience GmbH)
